fire and steel

The master swordsmith Arellano opens the doors of his workshop in Toledo after more than 50 years working by hand in his forge with the steel, the fire, anvil and hammer.

Master swordsmith since 2002, nowadays Antonio Arellano is the most representative craftsman of Toledo.

Master pieces such as the sword of San Pablo and the sword of Oton III stand out in his work.

Some of his pieces have been used in the filming of current popular Spanish series such as Águila Roja, Isabel, Toledo. Carlos V and La Peste and in internationals collaborations with Disney or producer Shonda Rhimes.



Nowadays, Oscar Martin Garrido is the only master damascener certified in Toledo. His work is clearly Renaissance in style and his pieces have a great singularity. His religious artwork and decorative plates, Quixotes, bullfighting scenes, landscapes and views of Toledo are highly valued worldwide.

precision in each hit damascene from Toledo



Damascene-style work is said to have been practiced by the ancient Egyptians, Greeks, and Romans, but was developed into a high art by the craftsmen of Damascus, Syria more than 2,000 years ago.

We can define damascene as the art of inlaying different metals into one another, typically, gold sheets and threads 24 kt gold, 18kt (green gold), and silver on a soft iron base by chisel and little hammer.





Discover the interactive damascene workshop and test your skills elaborating your own damascene work in 24 kt gold.

Working under the supervision of a master damascener, you will get a unique and customized piece while enjoying an amusing craft workshop.
